### STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	£2,390
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event, or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£610
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£115
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises.	£345
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from foil oak wood effect	£280
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£10
At a date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£1,030

#### **UNATTENDED FUNERAL**

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event, or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> In England, Wales, and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
